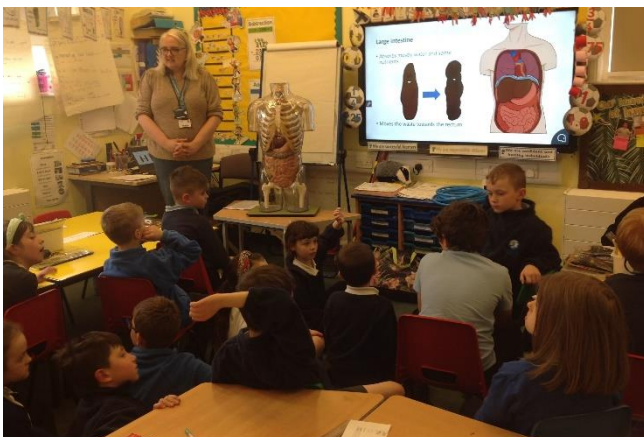
YR3/4 Time & Tide Visit
