

English:

- This term we begin with our Book Week where we will be writing our own informative non chronological reports.
- We will also be looking at narrative writing. We will read the book 'The Green Ship' by Quentin Blake and think about features of adventure stories. We will learn about dialogue in stories and write our own.

Maths:

- We start with fractions work this half term. We will recap equivalent fractions and finding fractions of quantities.
- We will also recap different units of measurement and converting between units.
- In our shape work, we will learn about different quadrilaterals and triangles as well as 3D shapes.

Science:

- This half term our topic is 'Rocks and Soils.' We will use our investigative skills to examine and classify rocks in different ways. We will find out about how rocks are formed and the different types of rocks. We will learn about fossils and why Mary Anning was important. At the end of the unit, we will look at different soils.

RE:

- In RE lessons, we will be learning about the Islamic faith and how it affects Muslims' lives. In particular, we will find out about mosques and the 5 pillars of Islam.
