English:

This half term we will be using the text 'Song of the Dolphin Boy' by Elizabeth Laird to aid our English lessons. The children will be writing a persuasive letter about pollution in our oceans and a discussion about the main character, Finn.

Maths:

We start with some more fraction work, looking at fractions of an amount. We will then go on to look at shape and position with a focus on triangles. Lastly, we will be looking at statistics and data.

Science:

This half term we are learning about forces. The children will have different experiments around the different forces of air resistance, water resistance and friction.

RE:

We are continuing to look at the key question of 'how do beliefs shape identify for Muslims?' We will be exploring the Muslim religion to gain a greater understanding of their beliefs.
