English:

Y1

Narrative: The children will explore the wordless book 'Flotsam' to allow opportunities for descriptive and imaginative writing.

Non-Fiction: The children will explore the history of lifeboats and local historical hero, Henry Blogg

Reception

Children will be continuing to focus on writing simple sentences independently.

Maths:

Y1

The children will be using practical resources and pictorial representations to explore; measure (money, length, mass and volume), shape, statistics, Problem Solving and Reasoning.

Reception

We will be focusing on developing our fluency. This will include counting, place value and learning some helpful number facts.

Science:

Υ1

For this last half term, the children will explore the season of Summer. They will learn about signs of summer, sun safety, clothing, nature and round the subject off with a written comparison of all four seasons.

Reception

We will be continuing to spend lots of time outside, talking about the changing weather and seasons. We will also be watching our sunflowers grow!

RE:

In R.E. the children will be considering 'Why do people have different views about the idea of God?'

PSHE and RSHE:

The Y1 children will be joining Mr Tate on Friday afternoons. They will be looking at 'Feelings/emotions/behaviours (Unit 8). We will learn about safe places to play and safe people to be with. As a whole class, we continue to have regular circle times to share our news and talk about our feelings, families, friends, interests and achievements! We will all continue to look at our current online safety knowledge and work on ways to improve it.

Theme (Geography):

<u>Y1</u>

This half term the children will be learning about the seas of the UK and oceans of the world.

They will also explore what causes waves and their effect on beaches and coastlines, finishing with some cross curricular art-based tasks.

Reception
