They came back with further information regarding the find. They said that it might not look like much but it is a piece of Samian ware made during the first to third Century mostly in Gaul. You'll see it is highly decorated and glazed, so not your normal everyday pottery! They have found a few pieces at Woodgate too. How wonderful to think it was in our library all this time!
