

English:

- English lessons will be linked to our theme of 'inventions.' We will be looking at explanation texts and their features. We will write our own explanations for an invention. We will apply our persuasive writing skills to advertise it.
- In guided reading, we will study 'George's Marvellous Medicine' by Roald Dahl.

Maths:

- We will begin with understanding fractions, their equivalents and adding/subtracting them.
- We will look at different units of measurement for length, mass and capacity.
- We will learn the properties and names of 2D and 3D shapes.

Science:

- This half term our topic is 'Electricity'. We will investigate how to make a working circuit and the different components needed. We will think about mains and battery power as well as how to stay safe around electricity. As well as that, we will investigate which materials are insulators and conductors.

RE:

- In RE, we are going to be continuing our topic about what shapes our beliefs.
- We will begin to think about the concept of 'truth' and what makes a truth. We will think about truths, beliefs and opinions and what forms them.
