

English:

- In our English lessons we will be reading some of 'Aesop's Fables' and writing our own fables. We will also be looking at traditional tales from different viewpoints.
- We will also learn about newspaper recounts and write our own reports.
- Our grammar focus is on conjunctions and fronted adverbials.

Maths:

- We start with place value, recapping learning about three and four digit numbers before moving on to decimals.
- We will also look at formal methods for all four calculations and applying these.
- Then fractions work, developing our understanding and calculating fractions of quantities.

Science:

- This half term our topic is 'Sound'. We will be learning about how sounds are made, how they travel and how we hear them. We will learn about how the volume and pitch of a sound can be changed. Finally, we will investigate different ways in which sound can be muffled, recording results and drawing conclusions.

RE:

- In RE, we will be thinking more about the concept of 'truth' and what makes a truth. We will think about truths, beliefs and opinions and what forms them.

PSHE and RSHE:

- This half term's PSHE work will focus on ourselves and how we grow and change. We will be thinking about ways people are different and celebrating our own uniqueness.

Theme (History or Geography):
