

English:

- We will be looking at traditional tales, with the focus of 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' by Various
- Guided reading – we will explore the book 'Jim and the Beanstalk' by Raymond Briggs

Maths:

- We will continue with shape and position initially, before moving on to number and place value mixed with calculation. We will recap fractions and explore statistics and data through our Science topic.

Will be looking at written methods using manipulatives and images to support conceptual development.

Science:

Seasons: Winter (YR1)

- We will be looking at the season of winter, comparing it with other seasons.
- We will look at how the seasons change and observe and collect data.
- We will also complete activities from the Crest Award if time.

RE:

- In RE, the children will be looking at the question:
What do Jewish people remember on Shabbat?
We will look at different artefacts and explore how they celebrate their day of rest.

PSHE and RSHE:

They will be looking at '*Feelings and behaviours (Unit 3)*' and '*Self-control & anger management (Unit 4)*'.
